DESCRIPTION:

TURCO EMULKLENE is a clear, yellow, liquid emulsion cleaner formulated for immersion type removal of cutting oils, grease and general shop soils from ferrous, stainless steel, copper, brass and aluminium alloys.

TURCO EMULKLENE is approved for use as an aircraft washing compound. It is especially effective as a corrosion resistant emulsion cleaner for use on dissimilar metals.

The product has an affinity for zinc alloys and tends to brighten the surfaces being cleaned.

USE INSTRUCTIONS:

Tanks: Tanks and associated equipment may be fabricated from mild steel or stainless steel.

Immersion: Dilute TURCO EMULKLENE with 5 to 20 parts water depending upon the degree of contamination.

Pressure Washing: Charge concentrate tank of pressure washer with one part TURCO EMULKLENE to 20 parts water.

Rinsing: Rinse parts with cold, tap water by spray or immersion methods.

DISPOSAL INFORMATION:

Dispose of spent solution per local, state and regional regulations. Refer to your local HENKEL Representative or HENKEL MATERIAL SAFETY DATA SHEET for additional disposal information.

CAUTION:

TURCO EMULKLENE contains a small percentage of chromate. Avoid contact with eyes, skin and clothing. Do not take internally. Use with adequate (equivalent to outdoor) ventilation.

Protective clothing, such as a chemical face shield or goggles, apron and boots and gloves, made from solvent resistant neoprene should be worn when using and handling this product. A respirator equipped with a mist cartridge, should be worn during mist conditions.

Store and transport in closed container.
